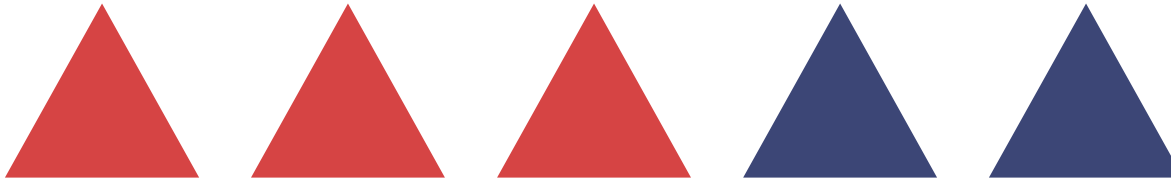


Reframing informal shared housing





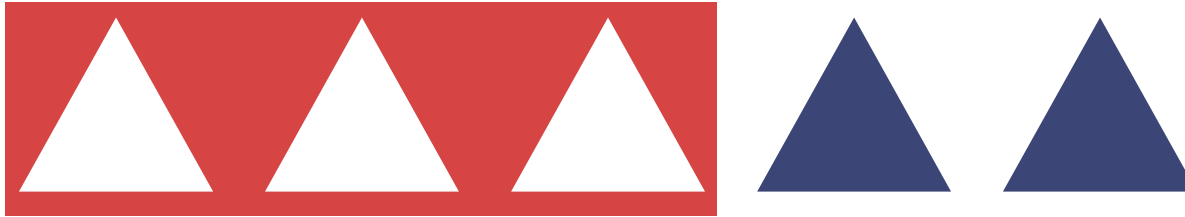
What do we know about informal shared housing?



Over three in five young adults ages 18 to 25 facing homelessness reported couch surfing over the course of a year


From the Voices of Youth Count U.S. national estimates (Curry et al., 2017)

At least some of these youth stay with a trusted adult or chosen family.

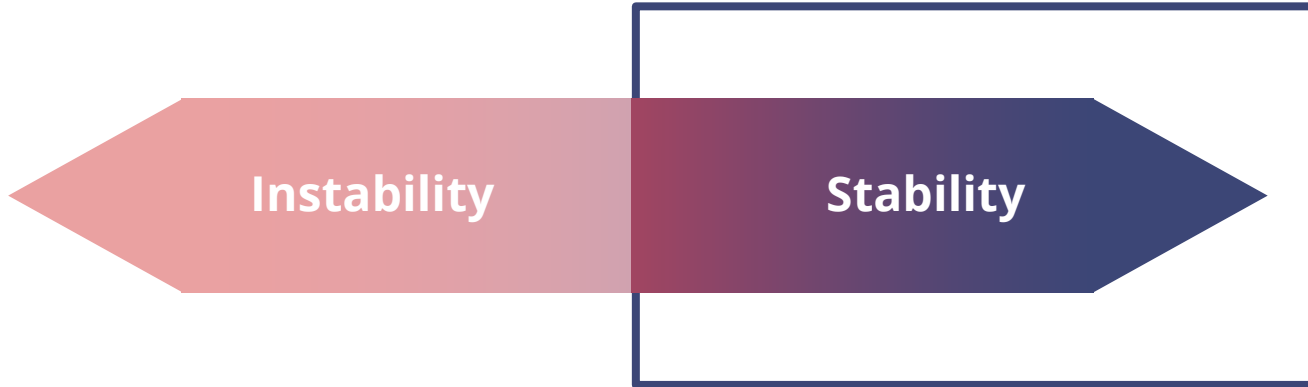

and her nephew.

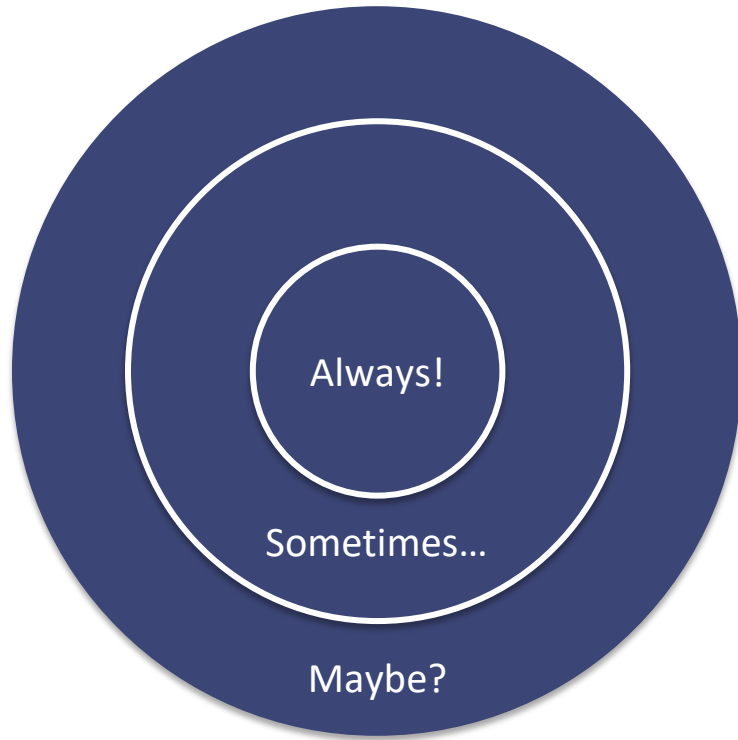

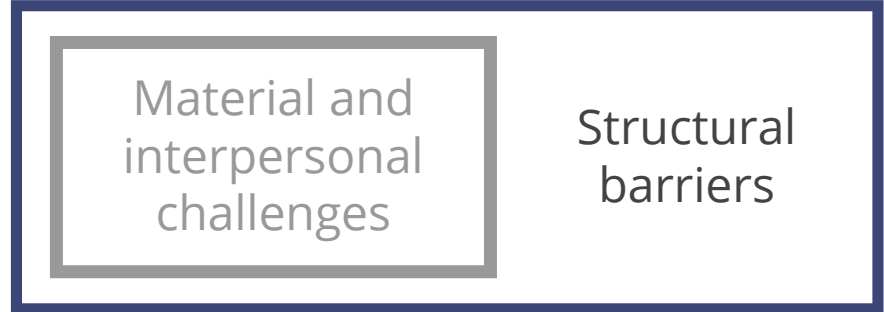



How can we help support and stabilize chosen family hosting?
