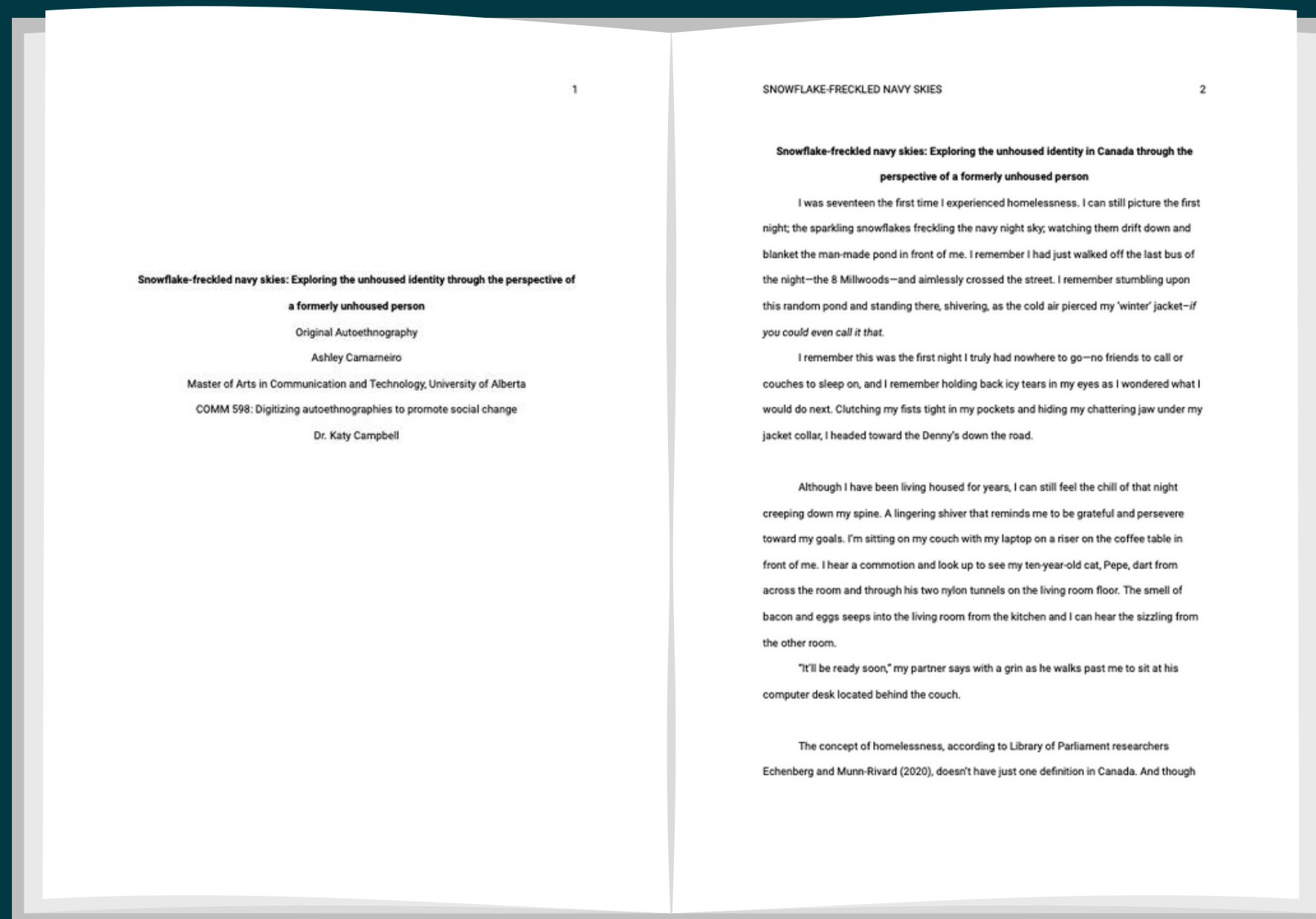

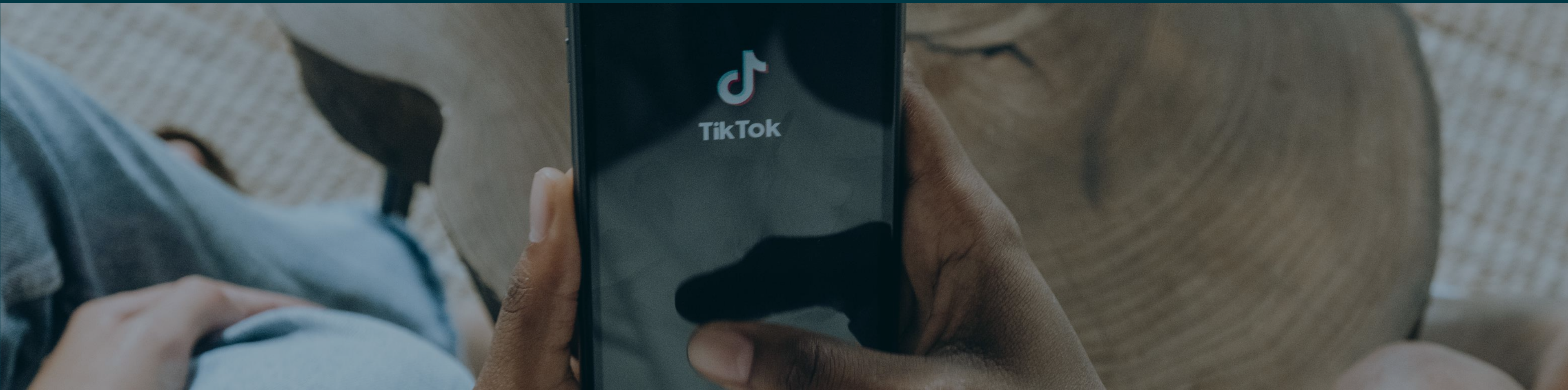

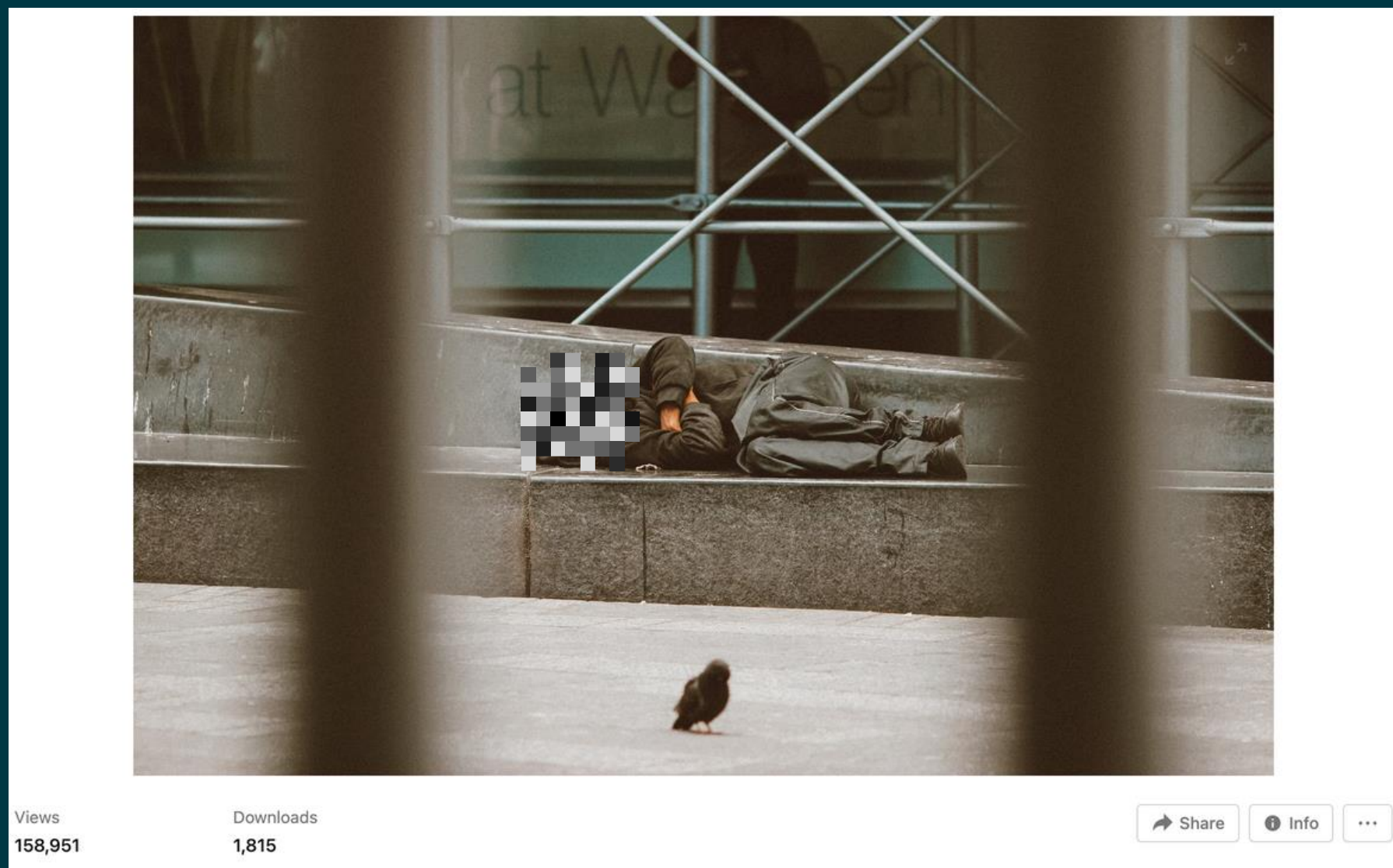

Avoid dehumanizing photos

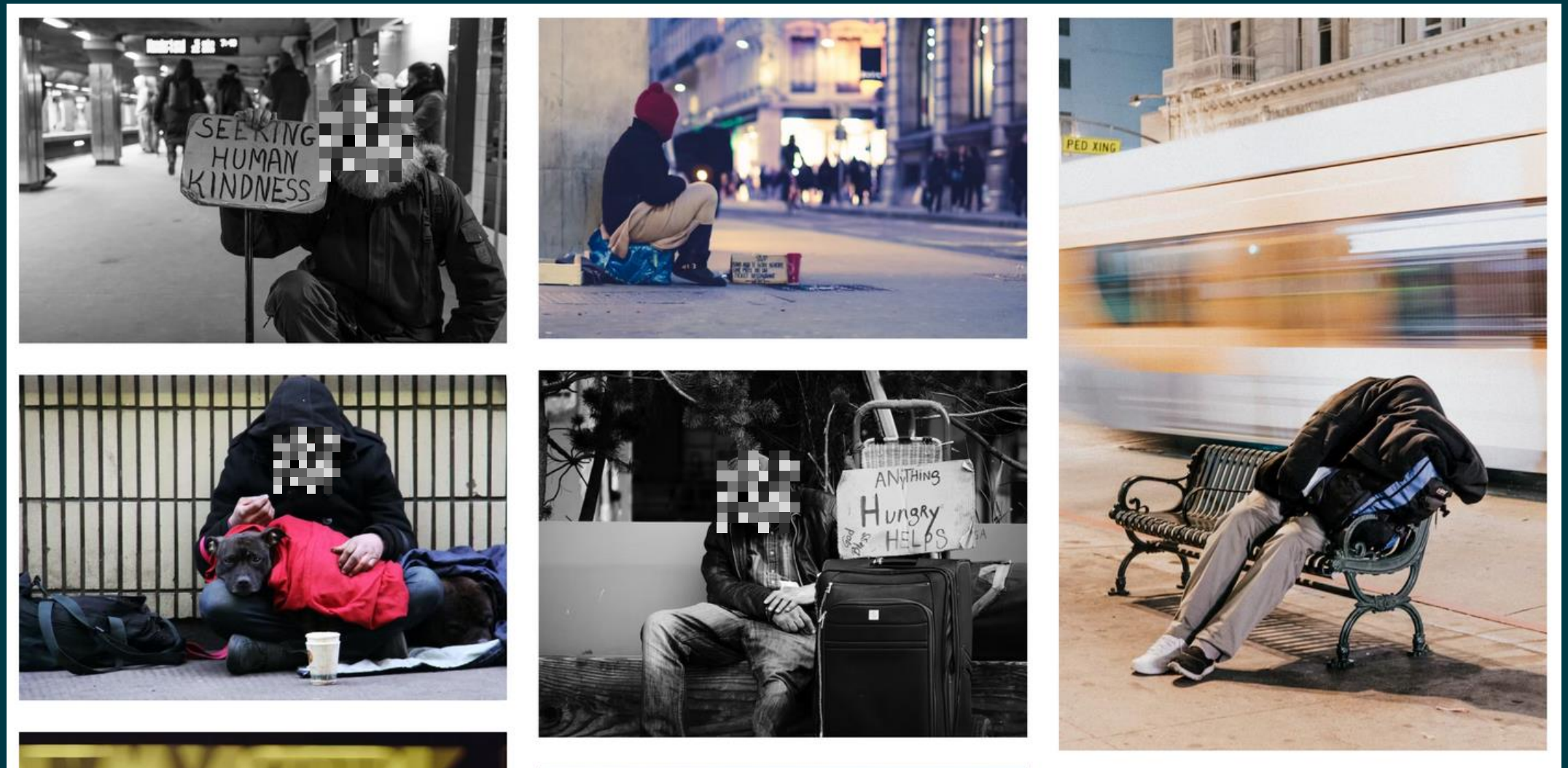
Avoid using stereotypical references

respectful






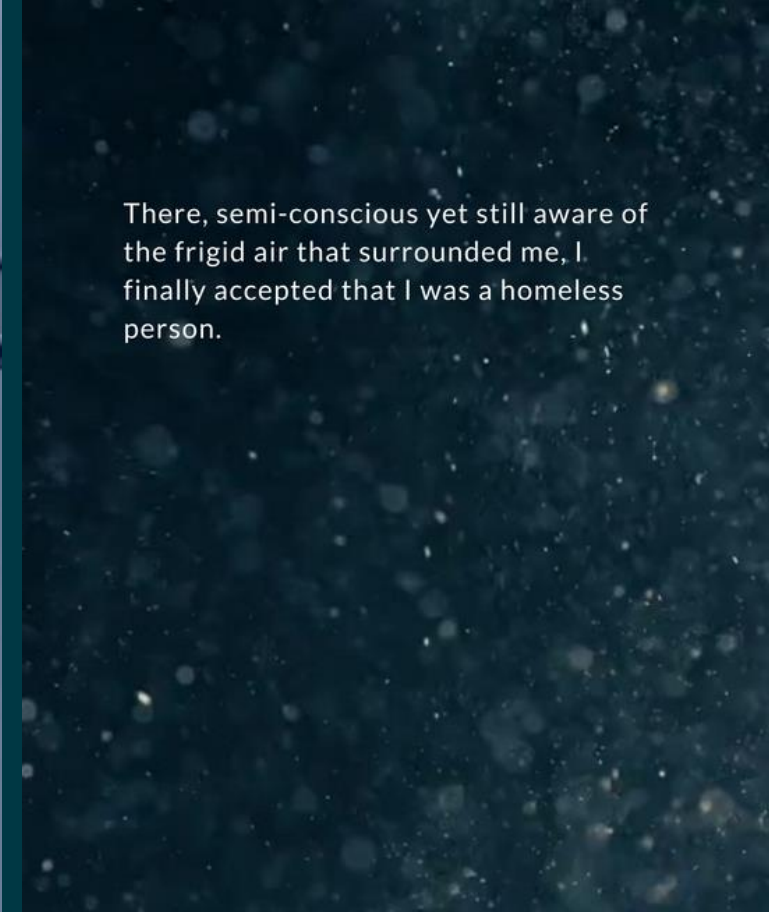
Final result

Shared a section of the story with way to view more



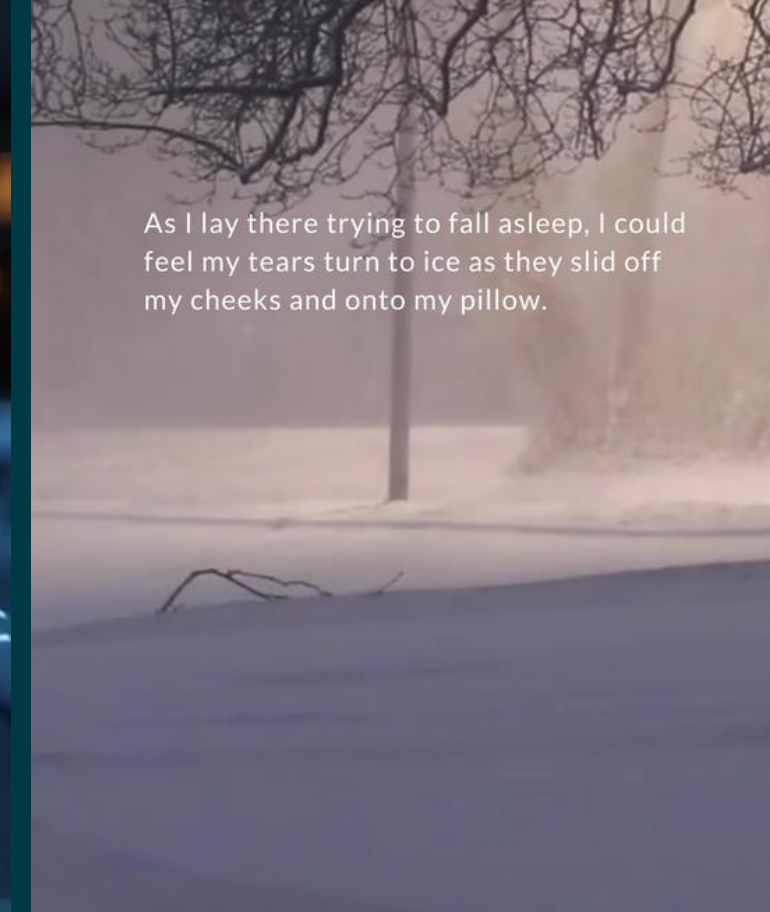
"You can't sleep in here," a loud voice pierced through my foggy thoughts.

As I lay there trying to fall asleep, I could feel my tears turn to ice as they slid off my cheeks and onto my pillow.



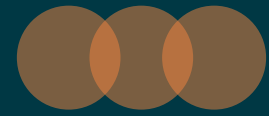
