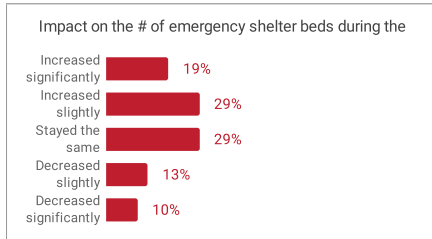

PPE	67%

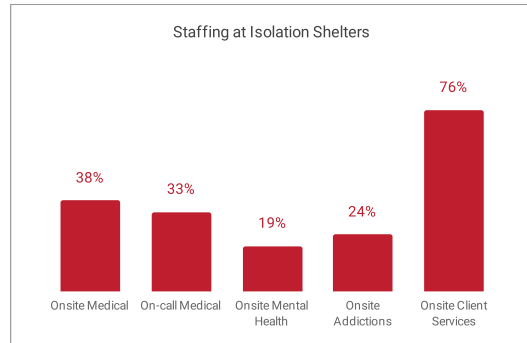
75% of communities have opened an isolation shelter in response to COVID-19

Isolation Shelter Spaces

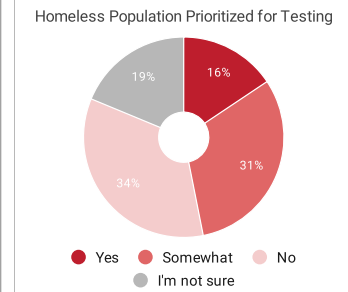
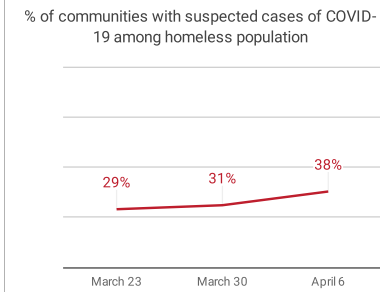
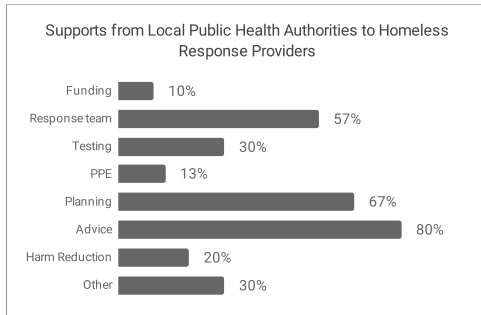

Top 3 challenges for Isolation Shelters

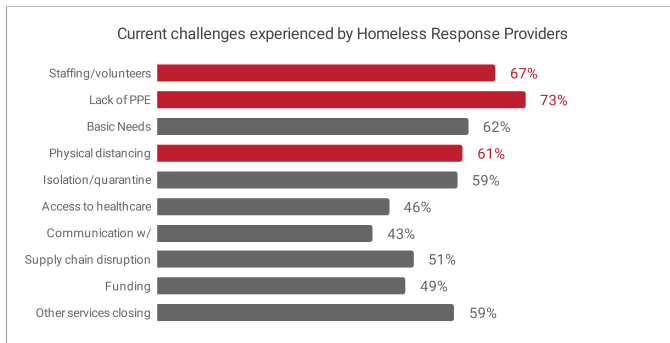
Lack of PPE	70%
