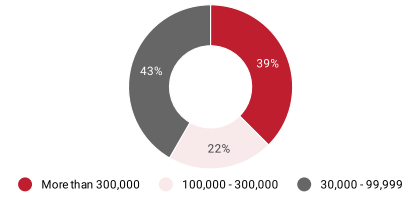

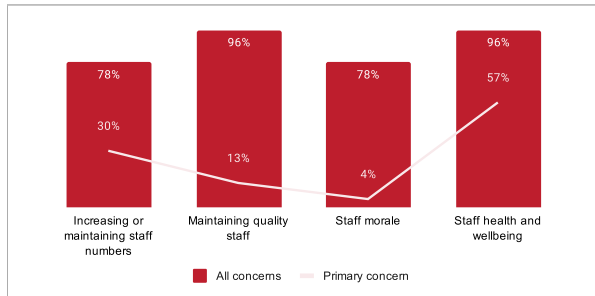
Atlantic Region	26%

### Staff Concerns

In the past two surveys we have distributed, participants have expressed concerns about staff. These concerns stem from uncertainties about the potential need to increase the number of staff and maintain quality staff during the pandemic. Additionally, survey participants expressed concern for overall staff morale and wellbeing.



### Strategies Implemented During Pandemic to Support Staff

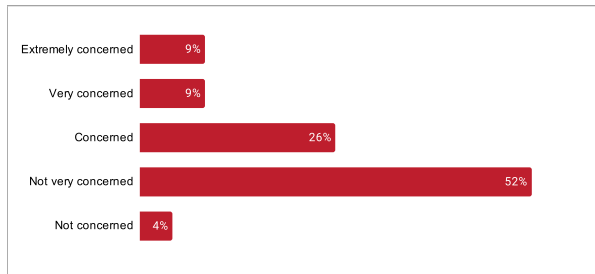
- Open and regular communication
- Workshops, webinars, virtual supports
- Pay increases
- Started offering Employee Assistance Program
- Increased cleaning, PPE, etc.
- Increased number of staff

- Continuation of pandemic pay
- Funding for contingency staff
- Additional training to strengthen supports
- Offering benefits
- Continuation of COVID-19 testing and screening

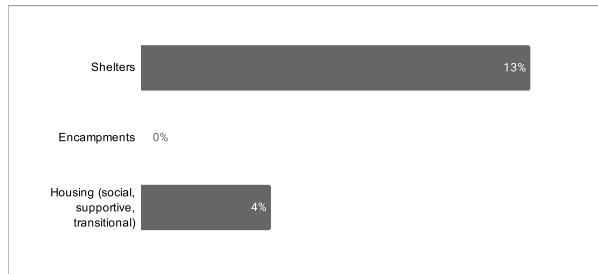
### Emergency Shelter Response

How concerned are you about having sufficient space for people experiencing homelessness to isolate and quarantine over the next month?

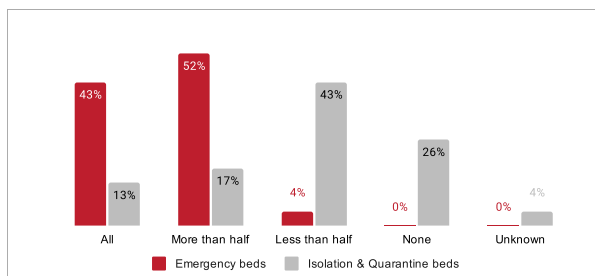
