



About the survey

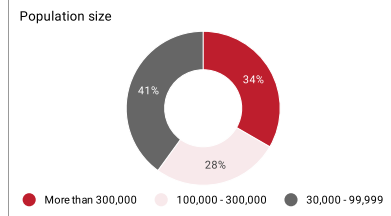

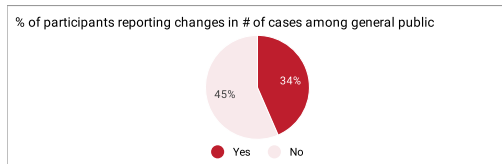
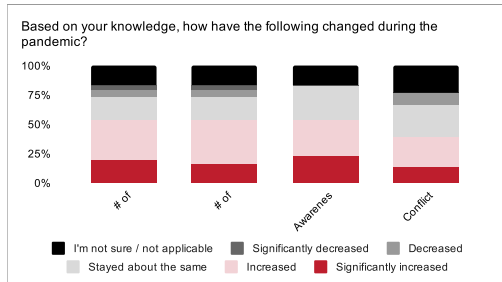
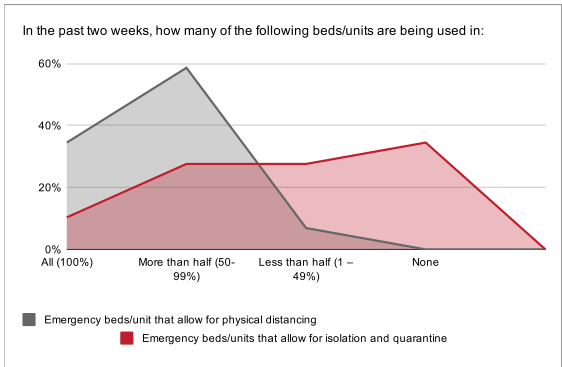
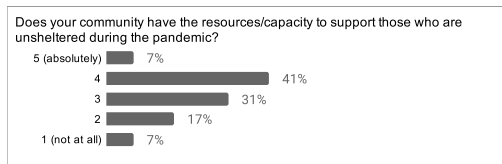
Second Wave

Unsheltered Response

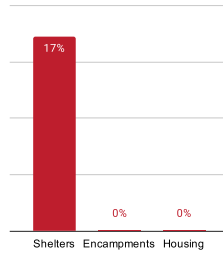


Outbreaks and Testing

Are people experiencing homelessness reasonably able to access testing in your community?

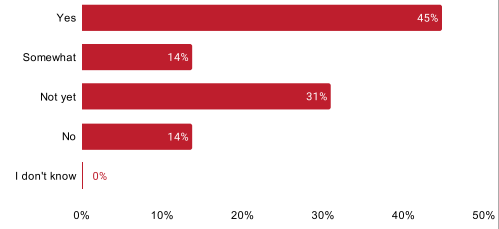


In the past two weeks, have there been any outbreaks in:



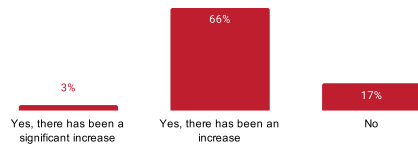
Winter Response Plans

Does your community have a winter response plan that is in effect (or ready to go into effect when temperatures drop)?

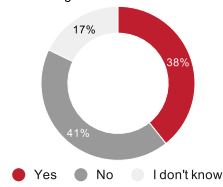


Housing Response
