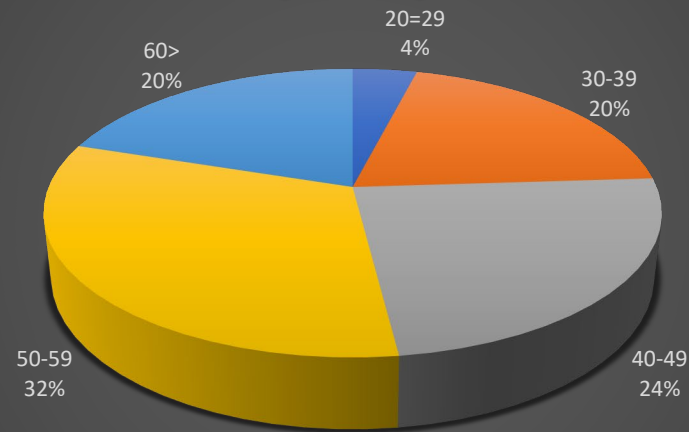

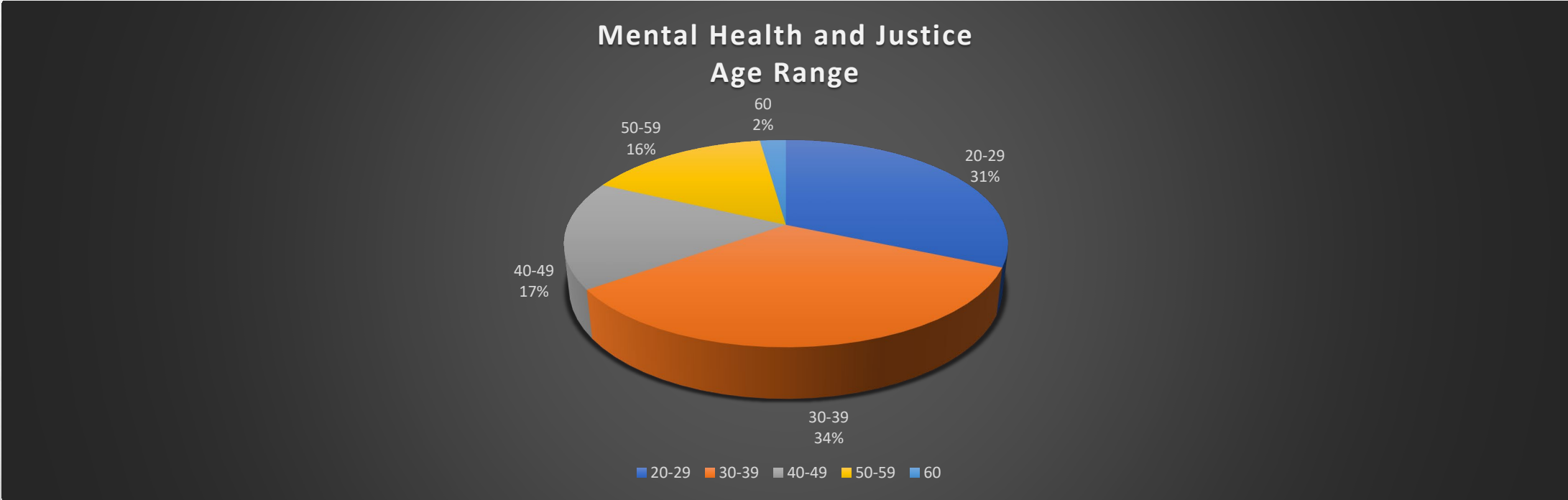
Assertive Community Treatment Team

Age Range



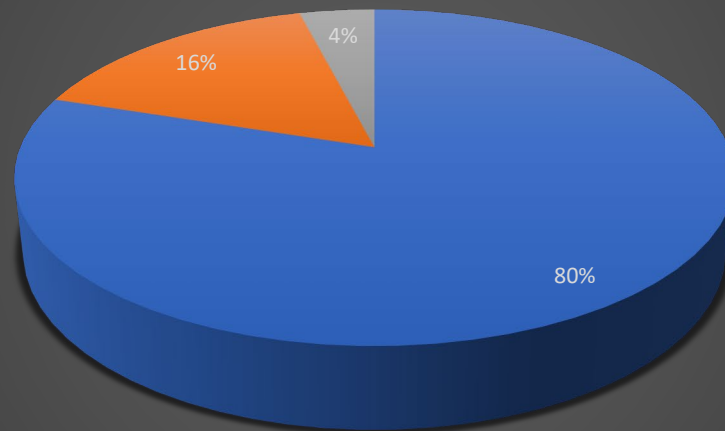

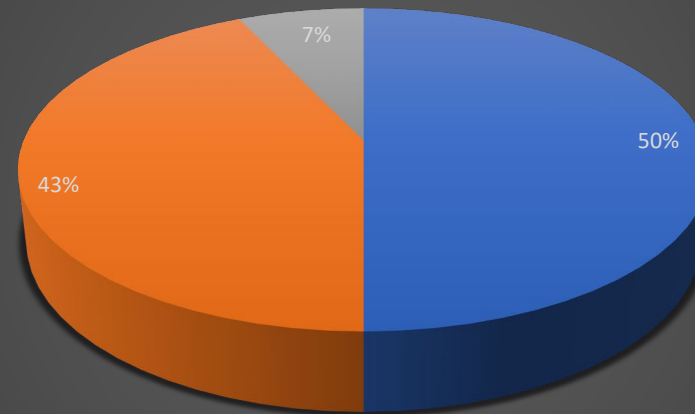
Mental Health and Justice

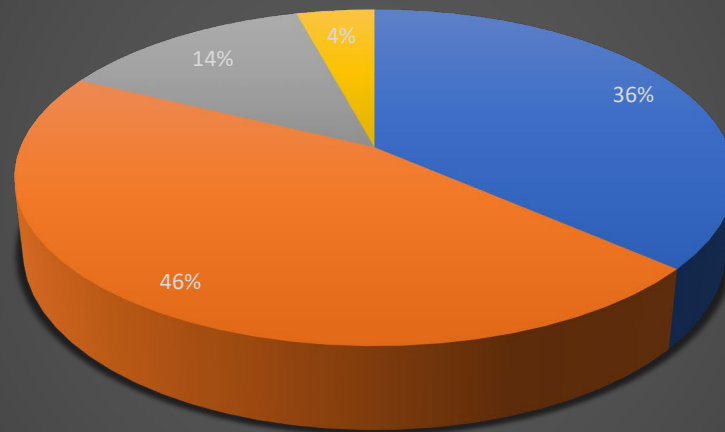
Assertive Community Treatment team Gender

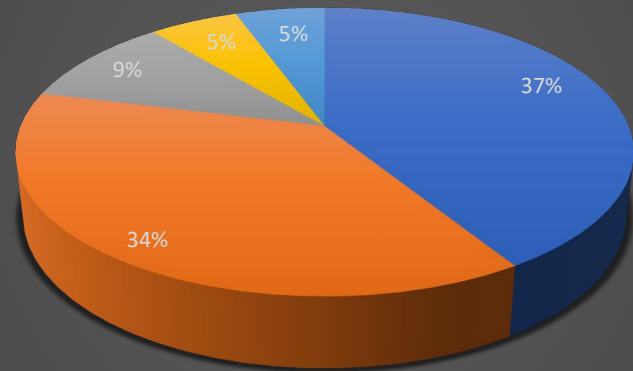

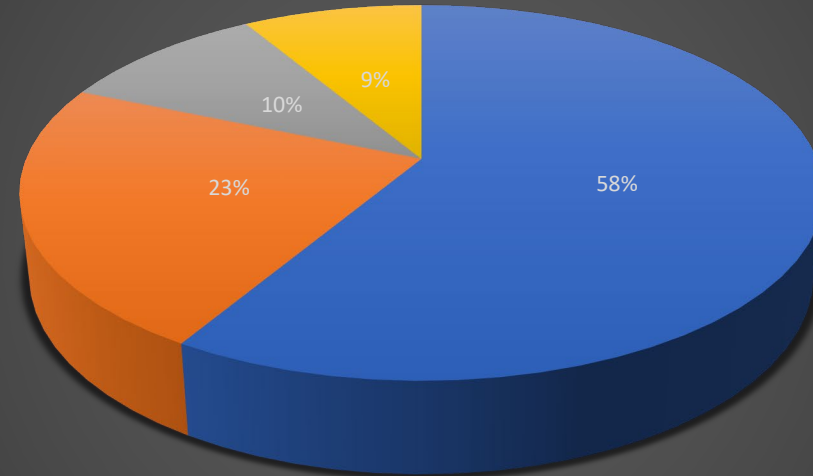

ACT TEAM CLIENTS

- **43 CLIENTS**
- **40 ACCEPTED INTO THE PROGRAM**
- **4 DEATHS- ONLY 2 RELATED TO OVERDOSE**
- **ONLY 3 NOT ACCEPTED TO THE PROGRAM- SEVERE DEVELOPMENTAL CHALLENGES**
- **3 TRANSFERRED**
- **4 DISCHARGES DUE TO LACK OF ENGAGEMENT**

MENTAL HEALTH AND JUSTICE CLIENTS

- **75 REFERRALS**
- **35 ACCEPTED INTO THE PROGRAM**
- **3 DEATHS – OVERDOSE**
- **8 DISCHARGED FROM THE PROGRAM – NOT ENGAGED OR TOO VIOLENT/ABUSIVE GO STAFF**
- **40 CLIENTS**
- **12 NOT ACCEPTED DUE TO VIOLENT HX PLUS ADDICTIONS PLUS PERSONALITY DISORDER**
- **12 REMAINED INCARCERATED**
- **16 NOT FOUND ON DISCHARGE**
