VOTING WHEN YOU'RE UNHOUSED

**Voting Day is
April 28th
9 am - 9 pm**

What is my voting address if I don't have housing?

Your address is where you access services, have a meal or stay regularly. This could be a shelter, drop-in, food bank, or community health centre closest to where you currently sleep or are encamped.

Do I need proof of address?

Yes. To get your proof of address, a staff person of the shelter, drop-in, food bank, or community health centre that you go to can help! If you request it, the staff person must provide you with a *Letter of Confirmation of Residence* form, which you will need to vote. You both must sign this letter.

Ask them to scan the QR code to the right for the form: →

Do I need proof of identity?

Yes. If you have any ID with your name on it — a parolee card, for example — you can use it to vote.

If you don't have ID, you'll need someone to confirm you are who you say you are **AND** who is assigned to the same polling station as you. They could be a neighbourhood outreach worker or another homeless person with ID. **Important:** this person can vouch for one person only — not multiple people.

This person must:

- Go to the polling station with you when you vote
- Bring ID that shows their proof of address and their identity
- Sign a form confirming that you are actually you! You will also sign the form

How do I vote?

Voting day is April 28th. Advance voting days are April 18th, 19th, 20th, and 21st. You can vote on any of these days between 9 am and 9 pm. You can also vote at your local Elections Canada Office until 6 pm on April 22nd during their office hours (Mon.-Fri, 9 am to 9 pm; Sat, 9 am to 6 pm; Sun, 12 pm to 4 pm).

When you go to vote:

- Take your signed *Letter of Confirmation of Residence* form
- Bring your ID **OR** the person who will be vouching for your identity.
