Determining future opportunities for reducing chronic homelessness in Canada through creation of high-quality affordable housing and supports.






## HOUSING IS A HUMAN RIGHT



## ANCHOR FOR PERSONAL STABILITY

For some of Canada's most vulnerable, housing stability is not achieved without on-site support.



## Permanent Supportive Housing

Provides a physical environment that is specifically designed to be safe, secure, enabling, and home-like, with support services such as social services, provision of meals, housekeeping, and social and recreational activities, to maximize residents' independence, privacy, and dignity (CMHC, 2018).

FOR THOSE WHO STRUGGLE WITH HOUSING STABILITY, LIFE HISTORIES ARE COMPLEX AND UNIQUE.




MANY INDIVIDUALS OR FAMILIES REQUIRE SOME LEVEL OF SUPPORT SERVICES TO ACHIEVE HOUSING STABILITY.




SUPPORTS: PHYSICAL OR MENTAL HEALTH, SUBSTANCE USE, TRAUMA, CULTURE, OR ACTIVITIES OF DAILY LIVING.



WITH INDIVIDUALIZED SUPPORTS BEING A KEY PRINCIPLE OF HOUSING FIRST, THESE PROGRAMS SEE HIGHER LEVELS OF HOUSING STABILITY THAN USUAL CARE.





## Case Study: Woodfield Gate

EST. 2019

Indwell's first supportive housing in London, ON.

#### 67 TENANTS

One bedroom or bachelor apartments.




"Well [I was] looking for accommodations connected to my disability. So, I'm on ODSP and my ODSP there's only so much for housing, and Indwell accommodates that... Then I think they match the rest of the amount for the apartment, so there's a donation or a charitable donation given to the cost of the apartment. So, I'm able to afford it, so affordable is primary."

"And just having like ... just having friends in the building that we could kind of still self-isolate with or isolate with, not in a perfect way, but in a, we still need, like Ineed to be around people for mental health. So, I don't think I, unless I had Indwell and I had like community online, Idon't think I made, would've made it through the pandemic without like a hospitalisation."

### Quantiative Analysis

Gain- SS: significant positive changes in behavioural domains (n=20)
Community Integration Scale: postive changes in frequency of social participation, no significant changes in psychological perception of belonging



## Making Permanent Supportive Housing Development Work

"Something changes when you see people as humans, rather than something laying on the side of the street... I think that's actually the starting point... people's humanity, and worth, and value, and some leaders, some communities get this.... seeing people as more than just their economic value is where this starts."

"Interestingly enough, it took 10 years of solid work, up until 2016, to convince any health planner policy decision maker that investment in a supportive housing development and builder and operator was worthwhile."

"We have typically, almost always, had to make a calculated risk on the financial investment in a building or in a property without any surety of success of the program model or funding."

Aiden, Indwell leader

"lattended a pre-pandemic town-hall meeting hosted by [Counsellor], and they were talking about the downtown core when Dundas Street was under construction and the impacts that was causing. I was very pleased to hear what seemed to be a resounding theme... [that] these individuals are a part of our community... And so, Ithink there are shifts happening in terms of supporting every individual."

"I love the creativity of seeing what doesn't exist and trying to make it happen. Finding the unlikely allies, the resources that aren't automatically fitting together and saying, ahh, that's the puzzle that fits here."
