A community coalition called the Transitions Action Coalition was starting around 1999. After 10 years it became incorporated.

A little bit about our history...

Some of the members of the Transitions Action Coalition joined a group in Perth who had registered a Charity and were interested in starting a shelter. Together, we agreed to abandon the notion of a shelter and focus on youth. Hence, we became Cornerstone Landing Youth Services. We started supporting youth in 2012.

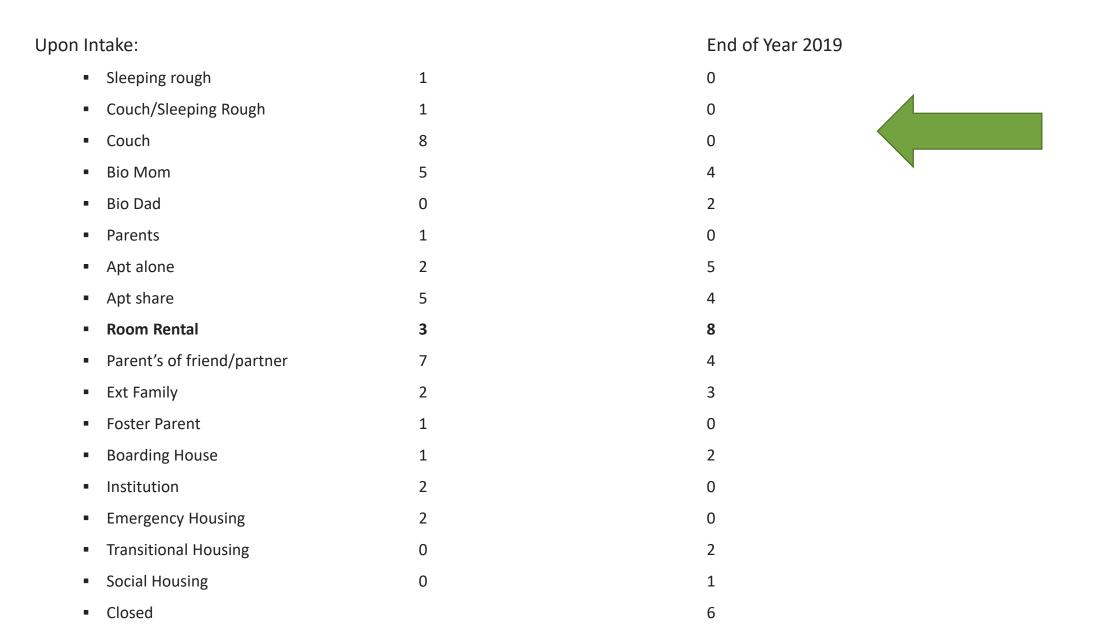
Housing First & Right to Housing

This is how housing first works – we move people from homeless to housed



Cornerstone Landing has supported:

- 82 young people age 16-24 in 2017, 62 were new referrals
- 74 young people age 16-26 in 2018, 39 were new referrals
- 73 young people age 16-28 in 2019, 42 were new referrals
- 64 young people age 16-24 in 2020, 28 were new referrals
- 55 young people age 16-24 in 2021, 29 were new referrals
- 71 young people age 16-24 in 2022, 36 new referrals



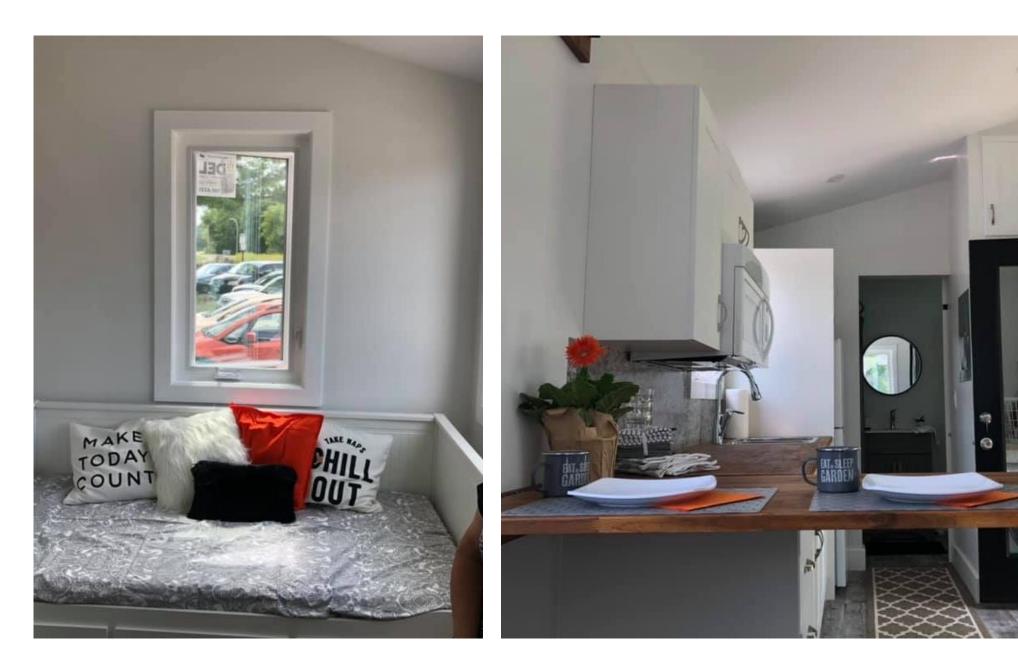
Did you know...

Although sleeping rough in Lanark County is not uncommon, a lack of emergency housing and increasing local house prices has found us supporting young people sleeping outside in encampments like this one.





In 2019, we built a Tiny Home for youth housing in partnership with Algonquin College!



In Dec. 2020, we bought our first house in Perth.

1 bedroom attached Additional Dwelling Unit (ADU) - Rent Geared to Income

We hope to use our tiny home as a detached ADU – Rent Geared to Income



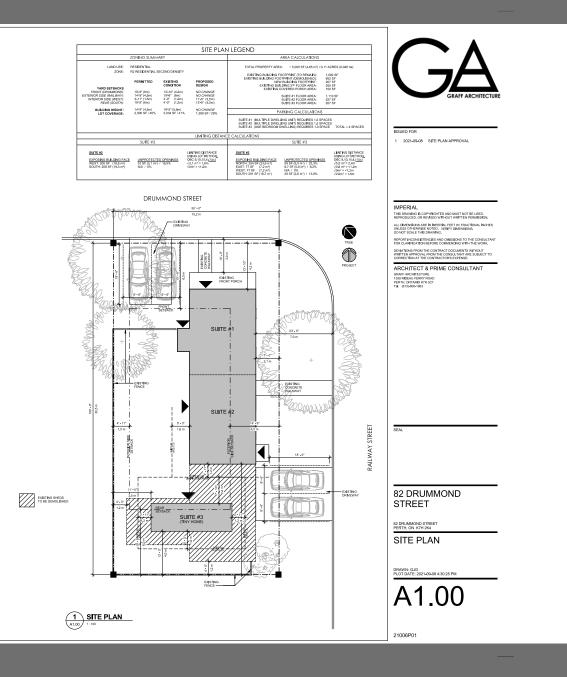

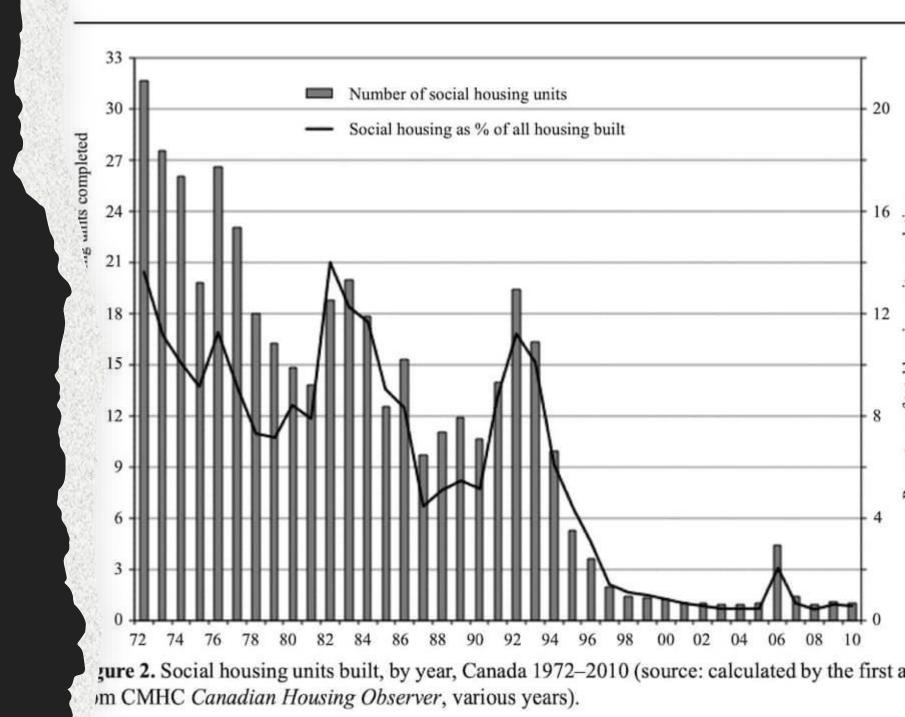
COVID – 19 Survey results:

24 Surveys completed in April and May, 2020 42% male, 50% female, 8% non-binary

When asked how COVID-19 affected them, they responded:

- 71% negative impact on education
- 67% negative impact on mental health
- 67% can't access services they need
- 21% lost their job
- 21% can't pay their rent
- 13% had reduced hours at work
- 13% don't feel safe in their housing
- 8% couldn't access wifi

The root causes of homelessness are many, but one significant factor was the complete divestment from all levels of government in social housing over the past 25+ years. This is one of the reasons we now have 250,000 people homeless every year.
