Realities for Youth

- 63% past or current involvement Child Youth Family Services
- 67% unstable housing in family or origin
- 66% currently have unstable housing experiences
- 82% dropped out of school
- 75% mental health issues
- 67% co-occurring mental health and addictions
- 74% addictions issues
- 72% unemployed or have never been employed
- 75% past or current involvement with the criminal justice system
- 69% repeat use of shelter (recurring homelessness)



Jumpstart Pre-employment Program

- 15 weeks of programming focused on:
 - personal development
 - food preparation
 - basic repairs and maintenance
 - peer education model
- 3 days per week
- Employer engagement
- Built around activities that we as an agency were going to do anyway

Impact Construction – Building What Matters (formerly Train for Trades)

- Energy retrofits to NL Housing units (300 completed to date)
- Modernization and improvement of NL Housing units (10)
- New affordable housing units (14 completed, 6 in progress)
- Major renovation to office building for CFY
- Private contracts

- Interventions/supports include:
 - Physical and mental health
 - Justice system
 - Conflict resolution
 - Poverty related (food security, income)
 - Housing/homelessness
 - Child protection systems
 - Medication maintenance
 - Educational requirements and supports
 - Connection with ICM teams
 - Addictions support (methadone support)
